



Positions available for NCEA Level 2 and 3 Teachers

Ideal candidates will be qualified teachers with University degree, a minimum of 2 years teaching experience at a NZ Secondary School, and a familiarity of the NCEA system. This is a year long program and we can make a commitment for all of 2012. Teachers will work with students-athletes:

- in small groups of 4-6 students
- Monday to Friday from 8:30 – 10:30am, and/or 2:00 – 4:00pm
- The teacher for each subject will work with the students taking that course once a week for one time block. *example - teacher for Math level 2 and 3 will come each Tuesday from 8:30-10:30am, while the History teacher comes every Thursday from 2:00-4:00pm.*
- We will require teachers for the student-athletes in following courses, so that we can help them achieve NCAA (US University Athletics governing body) academic eligibility:
 - English level 2 and 3
 - Mathematics:
 - Level 2 and 3
 - Calculus level 3
 - Statistics and modeling level 3
 - Natural/Physical Sciences:
 - Biology level 2 and 3

- Physics level 2 and 3
- Chemistry level 2 and 3
- Social Sciences:
 - History level 2 and 3
 - Economics level 2 and 3
 - Geography level 2 and 3
- Foreign Language – Spanish level 1, 2, and 3
